

He served as President of the National Association of Pharmacy Association Executives in 1978 and 1979 and as President of the Tennessee Society of Association Executives in 1970. he was also a founding member of St. James the Less Episcopal Church in Madison TN where he served in many capacities. Survivors include his wife of sixty-three years Evelyn Holeman Sharp of Nashville; brother Charles R. (Julia) Sharp of Cottontown; daughter Marilyn (Tom) Webster of Columbia; son Tom C. (Jennifer) Sharp III of Knoxville; grandsons Thomas Crosby Webster IV of Smyrna and Jonathan Sharp (Kristin) Webster of Brentwood; and three great granddaughters.
