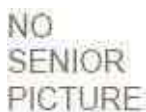

Accidental Blast Kills 16 Year Old Youth (Tennessean Sat Sept 24 1949) * * * A 16 year old junior at Isaac Litton High School was killed instantly yesterday by a shotgun blast that accidentally discharged when one of his two young hunting companions jarred the weapon. The dead youth is identified as Charles Goad who is the son of Mr and Mrs Carter Goad of 507 Ben Allen Rd. The accident occurred at 3:00 pm while Goad and his two companions Randall DeBow age 13 and Dan DeBow age 10 sons of Mr and Mrs L H DeBow of 731 Ben Allen Road were on a school holiday squirrel hunt. County schools were dismissed for fair day yesterday. The DeBow youths attend Jere Baxter school. Chief Raymond Cannon of the Inglewood Madison Police department was investigating the death and said the elder DeBow youth told him this story of the shooting. Goad was sitting beneath a tree about a mile and a half from his home with Dan DeBow eating walnuts that they had found. Both of them called Randall who was still hunting a short distance away. Goads double-barrelled 12 gauge shotgun was leaning on a nearby rock with the barrel pointing toward him. Randall said as he sat down beside

Charles he laid his single barrel 16 gauge shotgun beside Goads gun and in doing so the larger weapon fell and the charge in one of the barrels exploded striking Goad in the right temple. Immediately after the accident Randall ran to his home telling his mother what had happened. Mrs DeBow called chief Cannon who said that when he arrived both guns were lying next to the dead youths body. The body was taken to Cosmopolitan Funeral Home. Funeral service will be 2:00 pm September 25 1949 at the Eastland Church of Christ with burial in Pleasant Shade TN. . Carter Goad who is the father of the dead youth was in Kansas City at the time of the accident was enroute home to Nashville after being notified. The Goad youth was born in Difficult TN and had moved to Nashville about 5 years ago. He attended Tom Joy grammar school and was a member of the Eastland Church of Christ. He is survived by his parents and one brother James Goad of Nashville and his grandfather Howard Goad who is also from Nashville.

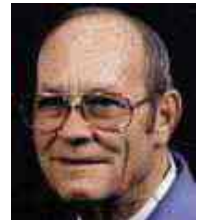

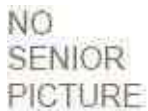
