He also helped film Vanderbilt athletic events, an experience that sparked a lifelong passion for Vanderbilt sports and made him one of the Commodores' most devoted fans. A licensed Professional Engineer, Ron served for nearly fifty years as chief engineer and owner of his Nashville-based engineering firm, providing design services for more than 5,000 projects throughout Tennessee and northern Mississippi. As consulting Public Works Engineer for Metropolitan Nashville and Davidson County, he designed and deployed hundreds of infrastructure projects that shaped the region's growth. Later, he directed infrastructure projects for a major telecommunications company and designed telecommunications towers across Tennessee. His expertise and vision also helped pioneer renewable energy development in the state, including the design and deployment of more than thirty large-scale solar generating facilities. In 2009, Ron founded Energy Source Partners, LLC, which became one of Tennessee's leading solar energy development and operations companies. Three years later, he established Energy Fit Solutions, Inc., a construction company specializing in solar energy systems and residential construction. Throughout his career, Ron was driven by an unwavering belief that engineering could improve lives and strengthen communities. His commitment to public service extended far beyond his professional accomplishments. Ron served on the Metropolitan Nashville Storm Water Management Committee from 1994 to 2010 and was an active member of the Tennessee Solar Energy Industries Association. He served on the boards of the YMCA and Miriam's Promise and dedicated countless hours to organizations seeking to improve the lives of others. Faith was a cornerstone of Ron's life. A member of Calvary United Methodist Church, he served in numerous leadership and volunteer roles over the years, generously sharing his time, talents, and expertise in support of the church's ministries and mission. Guided by a deep and abiding faith, Ron was committed to strengthening both his congregation and the broader community through service, mentorship, and thoughtful leadership. Recognizing Nashville's growing need for affordable

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housing, Ron founded the Blakemore Housing Trust in the early 2000s, leading the construction of homes for families in need. Later, he was recruited to serve on the board of the Clark Memorial Methodist Church Community Development Corporation, where his expertise in construction financing, site development, and infrastructure proved instrumental in transforming church-owned property into affordable housing opportunities. He also contributed to the work of the Tennessee United Methodist Conference's New Church Committee, helping the annual conference plant new faith communities and revitalize existing churches. Outside of engineering, Ron remained a lifelong athlete. A competitive runner, he participated in numerous national championships and devoted years of service to the running community. As president of the Nashville Striders, he organized races and events that inspired generations of runners and fostered fellowship across Middle Tennessee. Ron embraced life with boundless curiosity and enthusiasm. He loved traveling with family and friends, exploring museums and galleries, and collecting artwork that reflected his appreciation for creativity and beauty. He delighted in the challenge of Sudoku puzzles and spent countless enjoyable hours assembling intricate jigsaw puzzles. Whether solving a difficult engineering problem or completing a puzzle, Ron found joy in learning, perseverance, and discovery. Ron will be remembered not only for his professional achievements but also for his boundless curiosity, energetic spirit, strong faith, and remarkable ability to bring people together. He was a scholar and athlete, an entrepreneur and teacher, a leader and problem-solver. Friends and colleagues valued his wisdom, humor, generosity, and insight, while those closest to him treasured his kindness, unwavering optimism, and steadfast love. Above all, Ron adored his wife, LaDonna, and cherished his family. He found his greatest joy in the people he loved and the life they built together. Ron is survived by his beloved wife, LaDonna Merville; his children, Ronald Bryan Merville III and his wife, Shea, and Madeleine Merville; his grandchildren, Garrett Merville, Anna Clare (Merville) Gatlin and her husband, Will Gatlin, and Caroline Merville; his brother, Hamilton Merville and his wife, Susan; his sister, Melissa Merville and her husband, Philip Cheney; his nephews, Wesley Merville and Kyle Merville and his husband, Gary Fuller; and his niece, Katherine Cheney. Ron's legacy lives on in the roads, bridges, cell towers, and communities he helped build, the renewable energy projects he championed, the homes he made possible, and the countless people he mentored, encouraged, and inspired. His greatest legacy, however, is the example he set: a life marked by integrity, faith, generosity, intellectual curiosity, and a steadfast commitment to making his community better for generations to come. 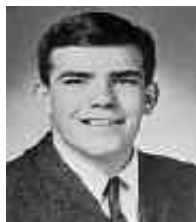

William Wooden was born May 17, 1949 and died June 28, 1981 at the age of 32 years. The couch where William Wooden fell asleep apparently with a burning cigarette probably smoldered for hours before igniting, killing him and his brother Michael who was sleeping upstairs, authorities said yesterday. The body of Michael Wooden age 29. at 4958 Edmondson Pike Apartment 7 was consumed by the flames which razed the entire downstairs of the two story Woodiea Condominium at 1:30 a.m.. Fire Marshal John Hagar said. Firefighters arriving

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after the downstairs of the apartment was fully on fire kept the flames from spreading above the first floor but Wooden's older brother age 32 died from smoke inhalation. A father and son who shared the apartment with the brothers and who were asleep in a downstairs bedroom were able to escape through a window which they broke open. Fred Wacome, age unknown, and his son Craig, age 28, said they had been asleep several hours before the smoke woke them up. A smoke detector which the apartment did not have would have detected the smoke from the smoldering sofa immediately and saved the two brothers' lives. A smoke detector no doubt would have saved them since this was a smoldering fire from the beginning. All of the neighbors were saying they would be going out to buy them now. Of course. it's too late for the two men who died. The fire marshal said Michael Wooden apparently was awakened in his upstairs bedroom by the smoke. but said the fire had progressed too far for him to escape. He was on the floor beside the bed Apparently he came to just in time to get up and hit those hot gases and just one breath and that was it. The younger Wooden never moved from the couch which burned out beneath him.
